

Conference Registration

The California Small Farm Conference is the state's premier gathering of small farmers and those that support them. Register today to be a part of this exciting educational event. Advance registration will only be available through 4:00pm on Thursday, February 26. After that time, registrations will only be accepted at the conference registration desk at the Radisson Sacramento. If you register onsite at the conference, you can participate in any workshop that you like. You may be able to participate in a short course or a meal session if space is available. Tickets for those sessions will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis. The conference registration fee – \$100 if paid by January 16, 2009 and \$135 if paid after January 16, 2009 – includes the keynote address and the workshops. The Short Courses can be added for an additional fee of \$50 each. Space in all Short Courses is limited and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. All Short Courses include round-trip transportation from the Radisson Sacramento to any off-site locations, and lunch. Short Course tickets may be purchased without a conference registration. This is ideal for friends and family that may be traveling with a conference participant and for those unable to attend the entire conference. Conference registration does not include meals. All meals are ticketed events and must be purchased in advance. You may sign up for the Meals Savings Package for \$95 each. It includes the Tasting Reception, one lunch, one breakfast and the banquet dinner. You may also purchase tickets only for individual meals. Meals can only be guaranteed for those registering before February 17. If you are traveling with friends or family members, you can purchase meal tickets for them, without purchasing a conference registration for them. There are three ways to register:

- Register online. The online registration system allows you to register for the conference, reserve your Short Course and select your meals. You can pay online with a major credit card and get an instant confirmation of payment and registration.

- Download a conference registration form. Download a registration form to complete and return by mail to PO Box 73614, Davis CA 95617 or by fax to 1-888-712-4188. You can include a credit card number for payment of conference registration fees, or send a check payable to California Small Farm Conference. You will receive a confirmation of payment and registration within 14 days. The registration form is in PDF format. To access it you must have Adobe's Acrobat Reader installed. You can download Acrobat Reader for free.

- Request a conference registration form. Call 1-888-712-4188, use the online contact form, or write to us at PO Box 73614, Davis CA 95617 to request a conference registration form be sent to you in the mail. You can complete the registration form and return it by mail or fax. You can include a credit card number for payment of conference registration fees, or send a check payable to California Small Farm Conference. You will receive a confirmation of payment and registration within 14 days. Important things to Remember:

- Short Courses and all meals are ticketed events. Your tickets will be available for you to pick up at the conference registration desk at the start of the conference.

- Registration does not include overnight accommodations. You are responsible for making your own hotel reservations at the Radisson Sacramento. Cancellation Policy: A full refund of registration, short course and meal fees will be made if written cancellation notice is received before January 16, 2009. A 50% refund will be made if written cancellation notice is received by February 10, 2009. No refunds will be given after February 10, 2009. Requests for cancellations and refunds must be in writing.
